A former royal capital and UNESCO World Heritage Site, it features landmarks like **Wawel Castle**, the **Main Market Square**, and the **Kazimierz district**. Krakow is also a popular base for visiting nearby attractions such as the **Wieliczka Salt Mine**, **Auschwitz**, and the Tatra Mountains.



HOW TO GET TO KRAKOW

BY AIR



Krakow-Balice Airport is located in the town of Balice, 11 km from Krakow. The "Balice Ekspres" is the fastest connection between the center of Krakow and the airport. You can also take a bus or a taxi from the airport to the city.

BY CAR

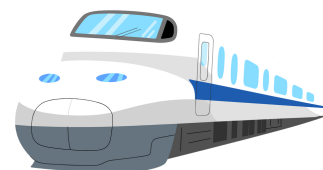


You can get to Krakow on the A4 highway (toll). This makes traveling from the west fairly easy. Driving from Warsaw : the easiest route is the S7 express road. The center of Krakow is a parking zone. Drivers pay at parking meters located along the streets of the city center. From January 2026 there is a Clean Transport Zone in Krakow.

BY TRAIN

All trains arriving in Krakow stop at Krakow Główny. The station is located near the city center and has connections to other cities in Poland and Europe. You can buy tickets online, at ticket counters or at ticket machines in the station.

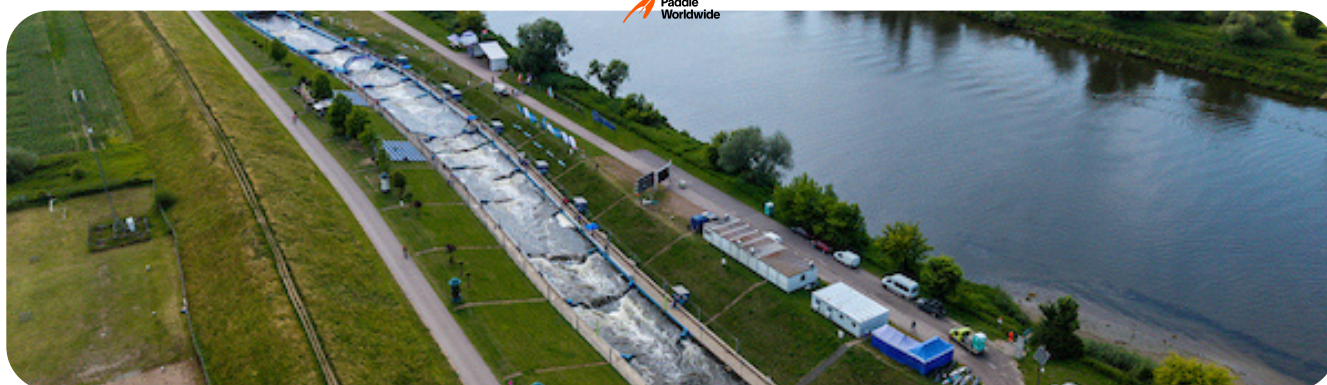


BY BUS



The PKS (Bus Transport Company) station is centrally located behind the Central Railway Station in Krakow. It offers both domestic and international services. In addition to ticket offices, kiosks, a bar and a PKS information desk, the bus station hall also houses travel agencies selling tickets for international routes.

KRAKOW CANOE CLUB



Krakow-Kolna Canoe Slalom Course <https://kolna.pl/tor-kajakowy>

Krakow is a host city for canoe slalom events and canoe freestyle, as it has an artificial whitewater course on the south bank of the Vistula River. The Krakow-Kolna canoe slalom course is 320 meters long and has a drop of 4.5 meters. It offers different levels of difficulty and features such as waves, holes, eddies and gates.

The course is open all year round and has a heated tent that covers the starting pool in winter.

The event will be a great opportunity to enjoy the spectacular sport of canoe freestyle and support the athletes.

How to reach the venue from Krakow city

The easiest way to get to Kolna Venue from the Krakow Główny Railway Station: by tram 52 to Czerwone Maki and by bus 203 to Tor Kajakowy. From Balice Airport taxi is the fastest transfer (around 10 minutes).

If you prefer to travel by public transfer you need to travel by train to Krakow Główny and then by tram 52 and bus 203.

Airport Transfer

Airport transfer to or from the airport is available for €25 per journey with sports equipment, regardless of the number of passengers.

You must enter the number of athletes you will be entering in each event through SDP. You must also provide an estimate of the total number of athletes and team officials who will be attending the event with your delegation. August 10, 2026 - 23:59 CET

NOMINAL ENTRIES

You must submit the name of each Athlete who will compete in the Event through SDP. You must also submit the names of team officials who will require accreditation for the event. These entries will be used to generate accreditation cards for all teams. **Nominal Entries close: September 15, 2026 - 23:59 CET.**

REMINDER

Entries or accreditation requests sent directly to the committee or event organizer will NOT be accepted. You must use the SDP to submit your entries and requests.

The certificates showing completion should be sent by each National Federation to ***sport@canoeicf.sport***

Previous certificates are still valid for this season. There is no need to repeat the program unless the person's role changes (e.g. athlete becomes a coach).
